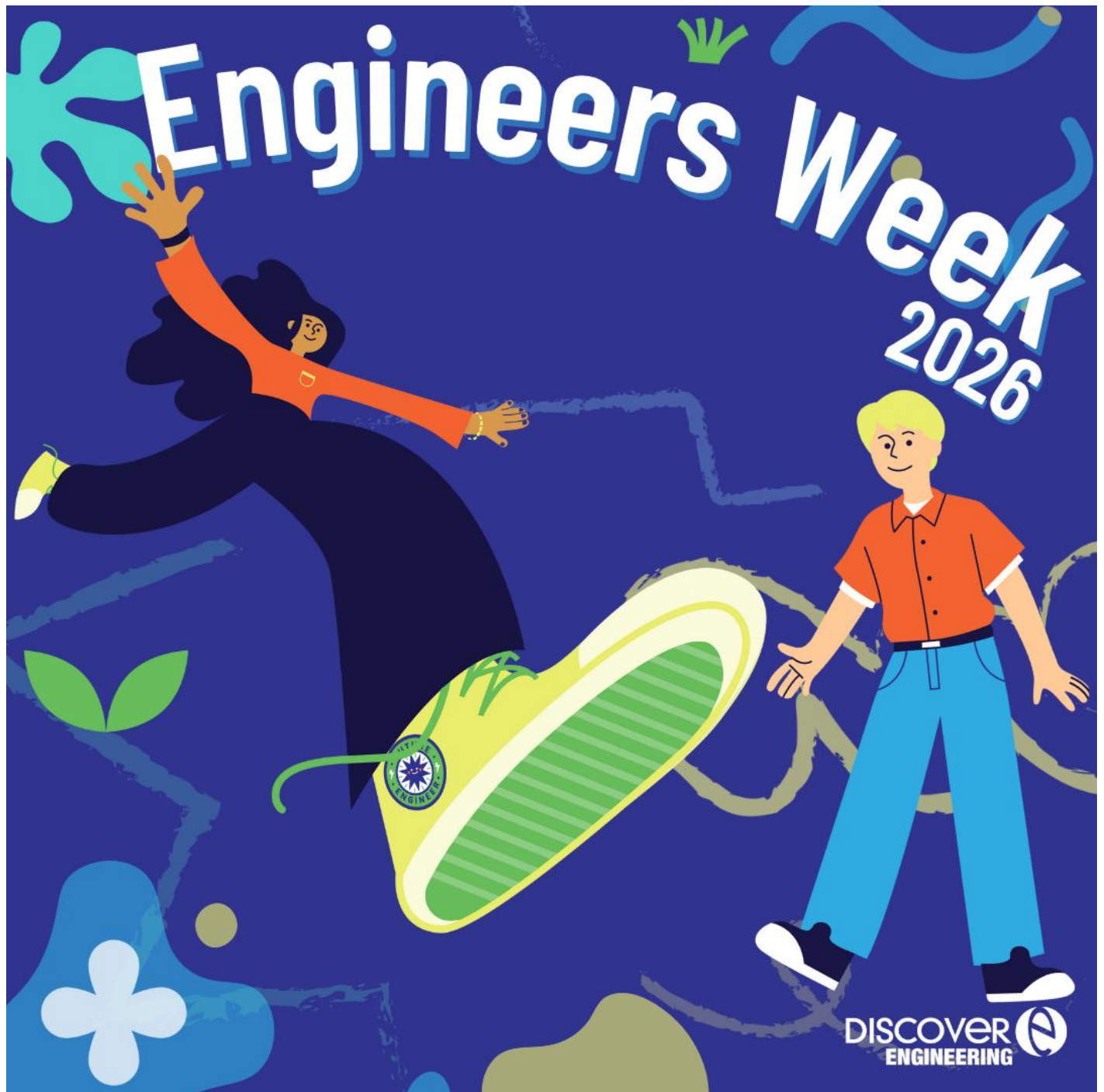


Engineers Week: February 22 - 28, 2026
